Rates & Registration Guide

The cost for Family Camp depends on lodging choice and the number and age of those in your family for meals. The following will guide you through the registration process. The link to online registration can be found on our website here: http://www.ridgehaven.org/registration. Family Camp Registration will open to the public on November 16th at 1:00pm EST.

1. List Each Attendee

Each member of your family will be listed in one of the following categories: Adult (18+), Youth (12-17), Child (6-11) Child (2-5), Child (under 2). The category will be based on *each person's age* on the first day of the camp week. If you attended Family Camp any year from 2020 – 2023, your family members and their information will already be saved! *Important Note:* You *must* put "0" for any unused age category.

2. Select Lodging

You will select a lodging option from the options below based on the number of family members.

Air-Conditioned Motel Style Rooms:

Large rooms are in the Averett Building with a private bath per room. 1 or 2 room options available.

Standard rooms are in one of our Cluster Lodges with a private bath per room.

NEW! Bunkhouse rooms are brand-new youth/camper cabins with 12 sets of bunks (24 twins) and private showers & toilets and open sinks. These are low to the ground with very few steps. Located very close to the Badger Barn Gym and central to campus.

Open-Air Cabins:

You may choose from one of our three Open-Air cabin villages which offer a more rustic camping experience.

Shenandoah "Treehouse" Cabins are located in the middle of campus, sit up high on "stilts," and have one large bathhouse.

Creekside and Mudgeville Cabins are a 15-minute walk to the center of campus (there is parking available nearby for guests that wish to drive back and forth). Both villages are surrounded by large shade trees, enjoy a couple of cool, babbling creeks, and a shared bathhouse.

Creekside cabins are on stilts with stairs and Mudgeville cabins are lower to the ground with minimal stairs.

Bring Your Own Lodging:

Bring your family in your RV or camper and stay in one of our renovated RV sites. Full hook-up with 30- and 50- amp electric at each site. Located close to amenities, a comfortable 5-minute walk to Jolly Dining Hall.

3. Meals

During the registration process, you will enter the count for each price range (see chart). Meal cost includes all meals and snacks from Monday dinner through Saturday breakfast. *Note: you don't have the option to pick and choose meals.*

4. Complete Forms

An Additional Information Form and a Release of Liability Waiver, 1 per family, must be completed to register. On the Additional Information Form is also where you can list any housing requests, including listing lodging preferred instead of lodging you chose based on availability. This form is how the lodging waiting list is created, based on the date/time stamp of completion.

5. Payment

Head back to your dashboard and pay \$150 deposit (non-refundable, non-transferrable) to reserve your spot! Balances are due 2 weeks prior to camp.

- There is a "family limit" price set for those using our Open-Air Cabins. The following caps are applied for a family of 5: Shenandoah \$1,360, Creekside \$1,245, Mudgeville \$1,130. For each additional immediate family member add \$70. For each additional non-immediate family member add \$130.
